## Power Steering Leak At Pressure Feed Tube Or Union

Application

n All power steering equipped vehicles using a banjo-style pressure fitting or union.

**Problem** Leaks at pressure tube or fitting union after replacing hose or servicing the power steering pump.

Cause

Seal between the hose and fitting has failed due to a dirty or damaged sealing surface, gasket damage or reuse of the old gasket.

## Solution

- 1. Always use a new gasket at the banjo fitting.
- 2. Be sure that the sealing surface of the fitting on the pump is clean and that it is not deformed from its original condition. Even a small nick on the sealing surface could cause a leak.
- Torque the union bolt to the recommended repair torque (typical 52 Nm, 38ft.lbs. – refer to vehicle service manual for specific torque).
